flour.



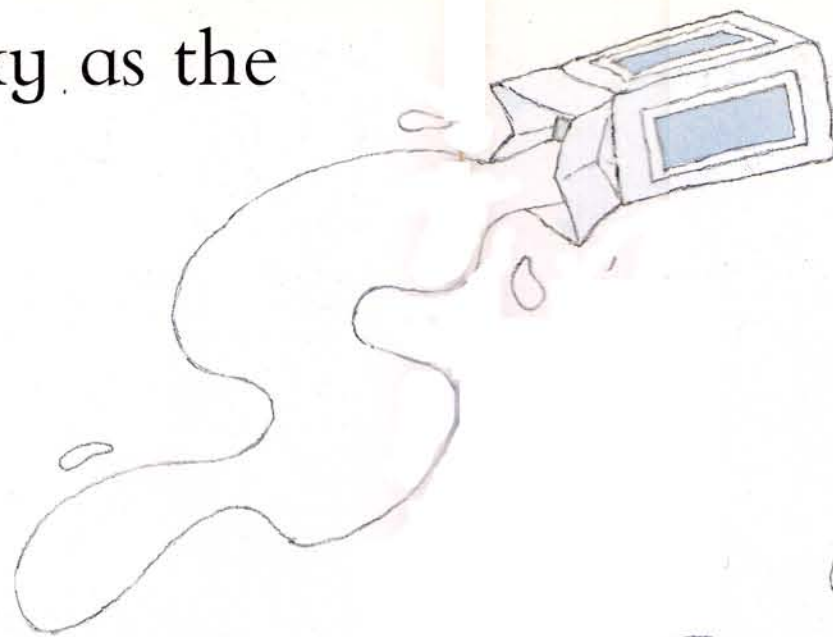
“I’ve got the butter,” said Foxy’s little sister.

“Yummy,” said his little sister as she licked the spoon.

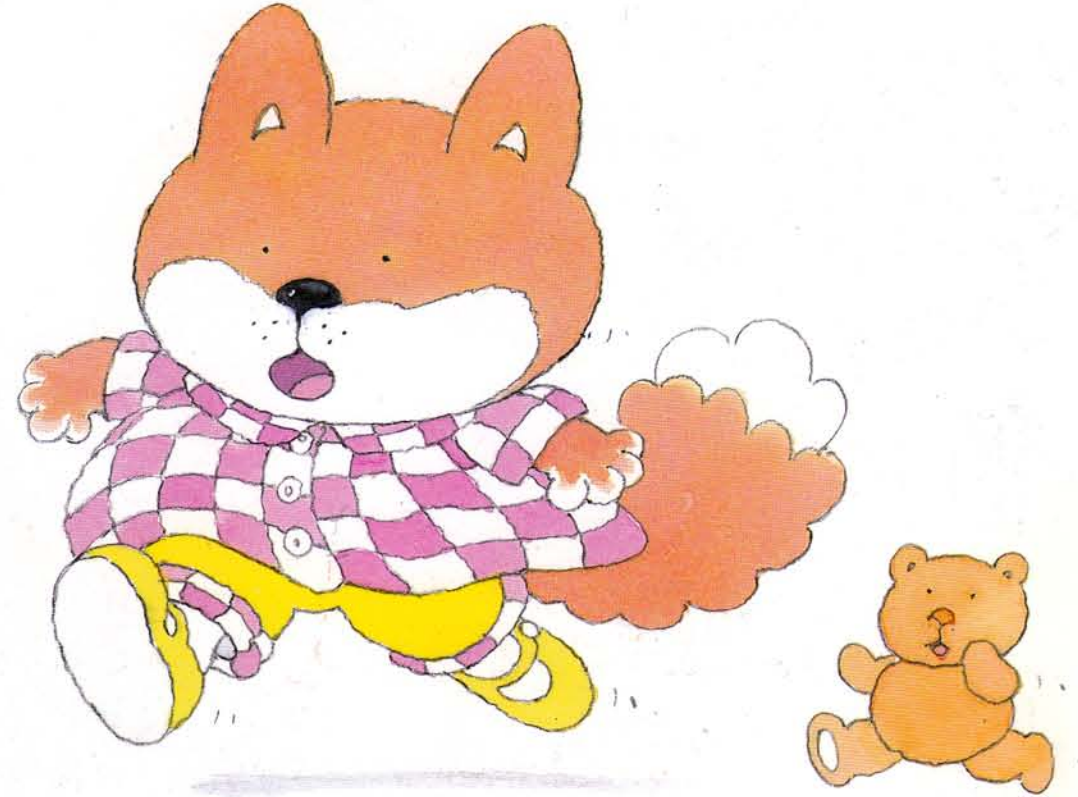


Foxy and his little sister did the washing up. They had lots of fun splashing and splashing in the soapsuds.
